We teach, act, and reflect on the attributes of the Learner Profile daily

- Attributes of the Learner Profile and Attitudes are permanently affixed to the walls throughout the school
- Students reflect on these attributes in their journals and in the IB Report Cards
- Our school creed which reflects many of these attributes is memorized and recited each morning

We actively seek out action and recognize those students who are making choices that reflect the attributes of the Learner Profile

- As a school, we seek to take action both locally and globally
- Students who exhibit these attributes are identified and recognized with the *“Taking Action to Make this World a Better Place”* award

We incorporate other cultures into each of our Units of Inquiry

Observance is given to all Cultural Heritages through school-wide events

All of our students (K-8) take Spanish as an additional language and learn about the culture of Spanish speaking countries

All students learn and recite the Pledge of Allegiance in both English and Spanish during the morning announcements.

The mural in the cafeteria reflects the seven continents. The people and the flag from each continent are permanently displayed on the mural. Artifacts and symbols are often displayed by teachers in their classrooms.

Instruction at St. Anthony is delivered with cultural intent by design.
